# Frequently asked questions

## 1. Where can we purchase the uniform from?

Our uniform providers are Natashas, TUS Schoolwear Ltd, Rawcliffes Schoolwear Centre and Academia Uniforms Ltd. No other supplier is authorised to sell our uniform.

## 2. What shoes and bag should I be looking for?

Your child should wear a sensible black leather/leather type shoe that can be polished. No trainers, boots or heels.

## 3. What colour is the tie?

The Year 7 tie is red. These can be purchased only from our uniform providers as above (also from school student services office during term time-subject to availability).

## 4. Are there after school clubs available?

We will be offering a variety of different clubs for students to get involved in from football to drama, from chess to gardening. Each club offers your child a chance to explore their interests and explore new ones with their friends. If we do not currently offer something that your child has a passion for, we would be delighted to explore setting up a new provision. Our students continually taken an active role in shaping and enhancing our wider community.

## 5. When is Transition?

At present, we are in a period of great uncertainty with regards to when we will access on site provision. Our priority is to ensure Year 6 will have an undisturbed transition process whether this be this academic year or next. Please be assured the year 7 team are in communication with all of our feeder primary schools and are gathering information to ensure all children have a smooth start. Keep up to date via our Website and rest assured we will write to you with full details of start dates.

## 6. What will happen if there is no transition day before September?

School will communicate all updated dates with you in accordance to government guidance as soon as possible via letter and on our website

---

## 7. How can I prepare?

On the website, there are activities for your child to complete which will allow them to familiarise themselves with the Oasis 9 habits and subjects they will be undertaking in September.

## 8. Is there a breakfast club available?

Yes. Students can access our breakfast club which is open daily to all students, where they can have a free breakfast and a drink.

## 9. What equipment will we need to prepare?

To enable your child to come to school prepared you should provide them with a rucksack type bag, a full PE kit with their name on, a well-stocked pencil case including black, blue & red pens, a pencil, rubber, ruler, a calculator, a maths set and a pencil sharpener at a minimum.

## 10. Is there halal options available?

Yes, halal options are available in school daily. The website is updated frequently for you to view the menus.

## 11. How do I let you know if my son/daughter has any medical needs or allergies?

You can notify us of any medical needs or allergies when you complete the data collection sheets which are sent home to all families. A member of the transition will be available to discuss this further closer to starting year 7. All forms are checked and school will contact you should they need any more information.

## 12. My child has additional needs, who do I talk to?

Before your child starts at the academy in September, we will have gathered important information from your child's primary school. You will have the opportunity to discuss any concerns with the SEND team or a member of the Year 7 team prior to your child starting with us in September.

## 13. What is the school going to do to support my child when they return to school and normality after lockdown rules are relaxed?

The school are already preparing assessments which will ensure we know where your child is up to in their learning.

## 14. How do we pay for lunches?

The academy operate a cashless system for school lunches using your child's fingerprint. Your child will need to top up lunch money on the machines placed around school. They will be shown how to do this during their settling in days in September.

## 15. What is the best way to communicate with school?

There are a number of ways you can communicate with the academy. You can contact school via telephone or email.

## 16. Our family has been affected greatly by Covid-19, how can we make you aware?
