

## BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate 510GLH

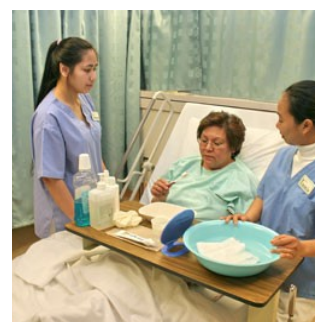

The **BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate** offers a focussed vocational qualification for learners who wish to follow a program of study related to Health and Social Care.

It is equivalent to one GCE A level and helps students to enter employment or to progress to a more responsible job if already in employment. Learners may also use it, together with other qualifications, to progress to higher education.

**Assessment:** uses a combination of external exam and coursework, allowing you to apply your knowledge and succeed in the workplace and develop study skills which will increase your chances of success in higher education and throughout your future career.



The Course: Students take three mandatory units.

Plus one optional.

1. Human lifespan Development (90 GLH) written Exam- set and marked by Pearson
2. Working in Health and Social care (120 GLH) written exam set and marked by Pearson
5. Meeting individual Care and Support Needs (90 GLH) assignment set and marked internally
14. Physiological Disorders and their Care. (60GLH)



### Entry requirements:

- At least five GCSEs at grades A-C
- or a merit at BTEC First Certificate
- An interest in Health and Social care
- A safe and mature attitude!
- An Ability to work Independently

### What can I do at the end of the course?

*Gaining this qualification gives you the potential to access University courses or employment at the end of two years. The qualification provides much of the underpinning knowledge and an insight in the world of health and social care, as well as developing skills in preparation for work and higher education.*
