BTEC NATIONAL IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY: CERTIFICATE 180GLH, equivalent to 0.5 A' level

Entry Criteria: 5 A*- C including English and Maths

Course Content and Assessment: This course is suitable for students whose main focus may not be on Information Technology, but for whom software and computing systems knowledge would be complementary. The course consists of two mandatory units:

1. Unit 2: Creating Systems to Manage Information (External)
2. Unit 3: Using Social Media in Business (Internal)

Progression Routes: Higher Education or progression into employment



BTEC NATIONAL IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY: EXTENDED CERTIFICATE 360 GLH, equivalent to 1 A' level

Entry Criteria: 5 A*- C including English and Maths

Course Content and Assessment: This course is suitable for students who are interested in learning about the Information Technology sector alongside other fields of study. The course consists of 3 mandatory units:

1. Unit 1: Information Technology Systems (External)
2. Unit 2: Creating Systems to Manage Information (External)
3. Unit 3: Using Social Media in Business (Internal)
4. One optional unit. (Internal)

Progression Routes: Higher Education or progression into employment



BTEC NATIONAL IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY: FOUNDATION DIPLOMA, 510 GLH, equivalent to 1.5 A' levels

Entry Criteria: 5 A*- C including English and Maths

Course Content and Assessment: Suitable for students looking for a solid foundation in Information Technology to be studied alongside other Level 3 areas of study which either contrast or complement the IT sector knowledge and skills. The course consists of 4 mandatory units:

1. Unit 1: Information Technology Systems (External)
2. Unit 2: Creating Systems to Manage Information (External)
3. Unit 3: Using Social Media in Business (Internal)
4. Unit 4: Programming (External)
5. Two optional units. (Internal)

Progression Routes: Higher Education possibly studying a Computing or IT related subject, an apprenticeship in this area or progression into employment
