

Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to clarify with you our expectations on uniform. At OALP we are striving to achieve our aim of; ***“Providing the best possible, education, care and support for all our young people.”***

We believe having high expectations of all our young people is critical to their success and would like to remind all our families of the expectations around uniform and equipment. Which are detailed on the left hand side.

Students will be issued with negative points for not meeting these expectations so can you please support your child be ensuring they are dressed appropriately and fully equipped every day. We need your help to empower our young people to achieve their mission of ***“At OALP I developed strong moral habits, achieved exceptional outcomes that enabled me to have a happy and successful life”*** during their time with us.

We would also like to clarify fully our expectations on coats being worn in the building, children are encouraged to wear an appropriate coat to school especially during the winter months. However it must be taken off on entry to the school building and cannot be worn in classrooms or on the corridors.

On your child’s PE day they are only allowed to wear OALP branded PE kit as listed on the left, no other items are permitted and inappropriate items will be confiscated if worn when they should not be.

We are reading school and are insisting that all children have a reading book in their possession at all times and your child must have one with always (For Years 10 & 11 an appropriate revision guide is acceptable).

We would also like to clarify that mobile phones are not to be used in the academy either inside or outside of the building. If they are seen they will be confiscated and they will need to be collected by a parent or carer.

We will be contacting parents individually if your child is not meeting our expectations regarding uniform, equipment and mobile phone use.

Whilst we acknowledge these issues, on rare occasions can be forgotten, may have been lost or have broken, this should happen infrequently and should be replaced as soon as possible.

I am certain we can count on your support in ensuring the highest expectations for uniform, equipment and mobile phones are being met so that every child at OALP continues to receive the best education they possibly can. As always, if you anticipate any problems in ensuring your child's uniform is correct then please do not hesitate to contact your child’s Year Leader in the first instance.

### All Students

Black blazer with academy badge  
Academy tie (Year 7 – Red, Year 8 – Orange, Year 9 – Blue, Year 10 – Green, Year 11 – Purple)  
Plain black footwear  
School bag (Be able to fit an A4 folder)

### Boys Uniform

White school shirt  
Grey jumper with red trim  
Black trousers  
Black socks

### Girls Uniform

White school shirt (with tie) or white tunic (without tie)  
Grey cardigan with red trim  
Black skirt (reasonable length) OR  
Black school trousers OR black shalwar (no jeans or leggings).  
Black hijab with school logo (optional)  
Black socks or Black tights

### Equipment for Learning

A pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and coloured pencils. For maths a protractor, compass and scientific calculator.

### Sports Kit

Academy polo shirt  
Academy Rugby shirt  
Black shorts or tracksuit bottoms  
Academy sports socks (outdoors)  
White socks (indoors)  
Training shoes (indoors)  
Football boots (boys)  
PE Bag

### Jewellery

Jewellery is restricted to a watch and, for girls, one small stud earring in each ear. Facial piercings are not permitted.
