Academy Leadership Team Message



We are really excited about STEM and have been working on the FIRST




Year 7 and 8 Accelerated Reader

Safeguarding Awareness

Have you heard about County Lines Crime?

This involves criminal networks involved in bringing in illegal drugs into one or more areas using dedicated mobile phone lines. The criminals will often use and exploit young children and vulnerable adults to commit the crime and will use violence and sexual violence and weapons to get what they want. It cuts across many different types of crime including child sexual exploitation, drug dealing, violence, gangs, modern slavery and missing people.
