What is the value of the missing number in the diagram?

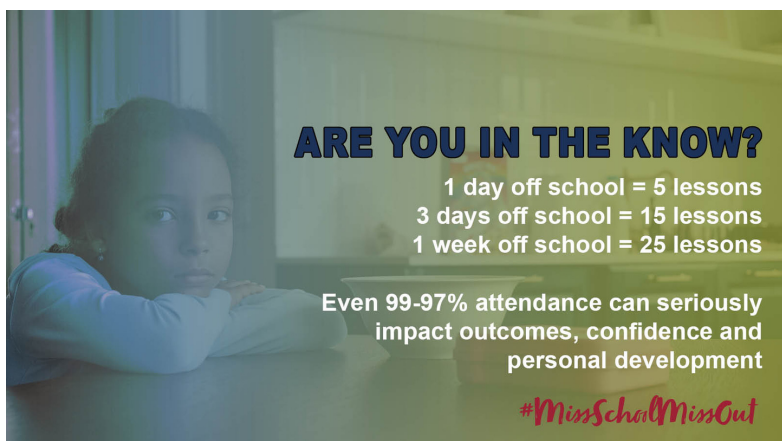
